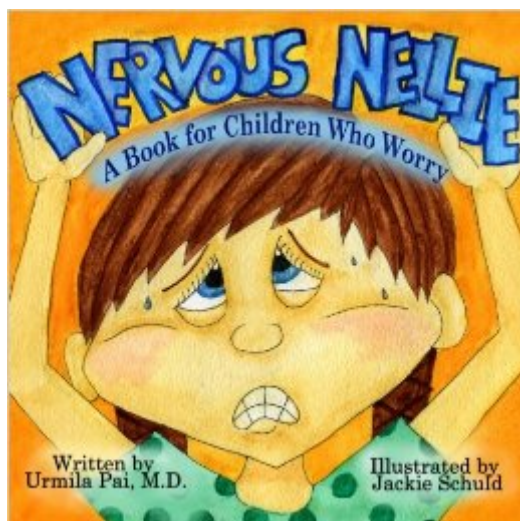

As an Educational Therapist, I work with children with Learning Disabilities, many of whom experience anxiety as a integral part of their lives.
